/ Mura Collective

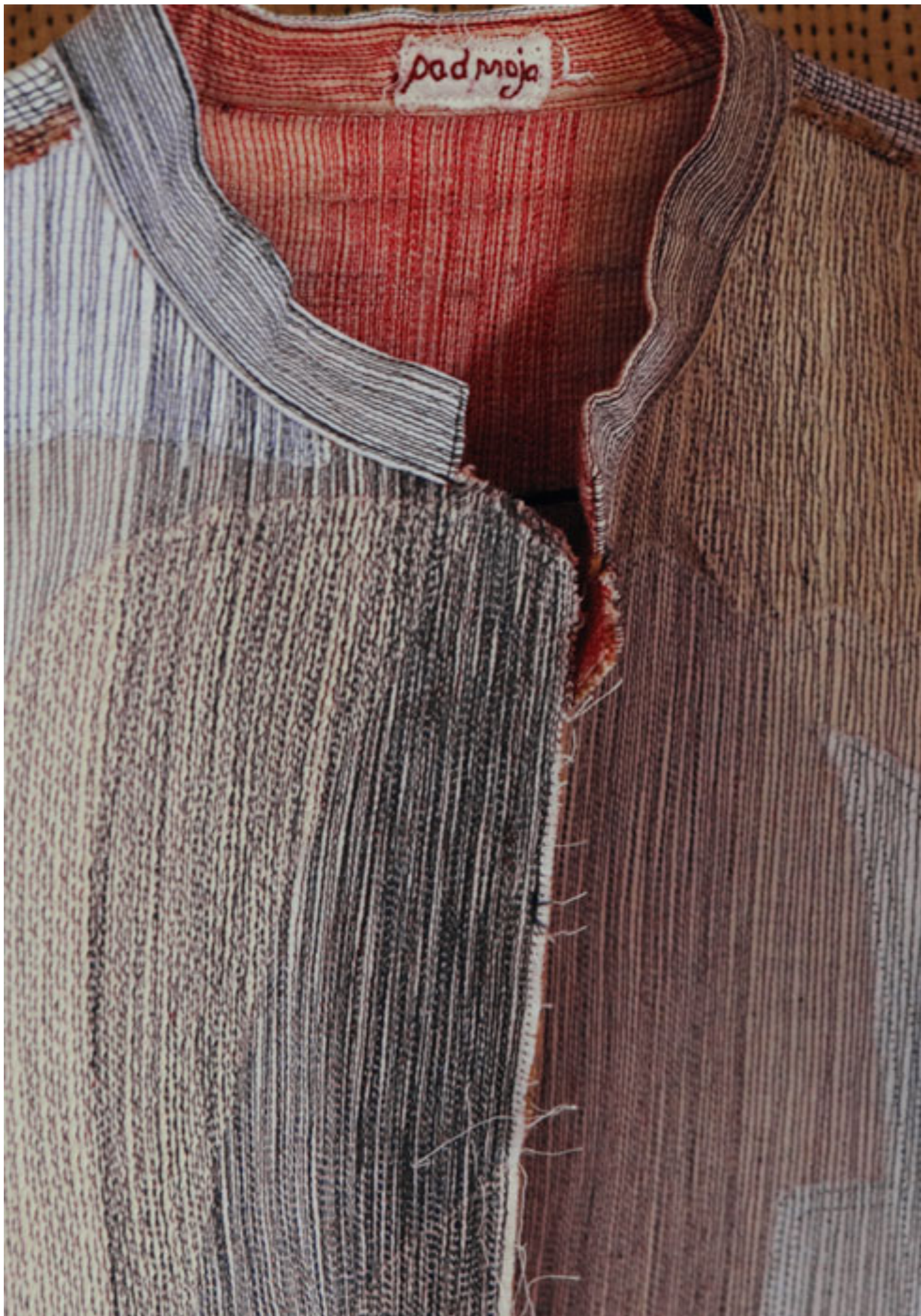

in a variety of indigo shibori patterns by the women of the  
collective.
